### **Position**

Project Coordinator/Assistant Analyst - Climate Governance Project

# Responsibilities

This is a full-time position in the research team, supporting research and coordination efforts for the climate governance project.

The climate governance project focuses on global initiatives to address climate change, including international conventions, multilateral and bilateral cooperation frameworks, and international mechanisms related to clean technology supply chains. The goal is to monitor progress and challenges in these areas, identify opportunities for collaboration, build trust among stakeholders, and promote technological progress to support ambitious climate action, the stable operation of global low-carbon technology supply chains, and the global low-carbon transition.

The Project Coordinator/Assistant Analyst will:

- Support the collection, organization, and analysis of information required for climate governance project research.
- Assist the project team in writing climate governance-related research reports, including literature reviews, quantitative analysis, field research, report writing, and engagement with the field.
- Translate, design, publish, and promote research reports.
- Collaborate with the project team on necessary external communications and quality assessments.
- Monitor developments and trends in relevant domestic and international fields, write opinion articles and conduct policy analysis.
- Assist in organizing domestic and international exchange seminars and activities for the project and iGDP.
